Shooting Location	Duncraig Senior High School Oval Readshaw Road DUNCRAIG
Shooting Times	Members shoot Saturdays 8:30am to approximately 11am New Archers Instruction 8:30am to 9:30am
New Archers Training Course	12 hours of training at one hour per week (8:30am-9:30am). New trainee archers are advised to arrive by 8:00am in order to have equipment allocated. (Please book first.)
Coaching and Instruction	All Instructors are Archery Australia trained and have Police Clearance and Working With Children card.
Equipment	All archery equipment is supplied during the Training Course. All bows are Recurve with right and left handed bows available at various draw weights and sizes. Trainee Archers must first undergo training on a Recurve Bow for at least six hours (or at the discretion of the instructor) before they are permitted to use a Compound Bow.
Insurance	Each trainee archer is covered by Archery Australia's Temporary Membership Insurance plan for the '12 hour Training Program'.
Costs	Each trainee archer is charged \$20 for the first one hour lesson and \$15 for each lesson thereafter up to 12 lessons in total (subject to regular review).
Club and AA/AWA Membership	After completing six hours of training, the trainee archer has the opportunity to apply for membership of the Club or can continue with a further six hours of training. After the total 12 hours training, the trainee archer will not be permitted to continue shooting unless they apply for membership of the Club and their application is accepted. Joining Fees are \$270 per Senior and \$200 per Junior. Family plans are available (costs subject to regular review). Club Uniform (shirt) may be purchased from the Treasurer.
