Shooting Times	Members shoot Saturdays 8:30am to approximately 11am New Archers Instruction 8:30am to 9:30am
New Archers Training Course	Maximum 12 week training course from 8:30am to 9:30am New Archers are advised to arrive by 8:00am in order to have equipment allocated.
Coaching and Instruction	All Instructors are Archery Australia trained and have Police Clearance and Working With Children card.
Equipment	All archery equipment can be supplied during the Training Course. All bows are Recurve with right and left handed bows available at various draw weights. Trainee Archers must first undergo training on a Recurve Bow before they are permitted to use a Compound Bow.
Insurance	Each trainee archer is covered by Archery Australia's temporary membership Insurance plan for the 12 Week Training Program
Costs	Each trainee archer may have one free visit. Any further visits are charged at \$150 for 6 sessions up to 12 lessons in total.
Club, and AA/AWA Membership	After the completion of 6 weeks training the trainee archer has the opportunity to apply for membership of the Club or can continue with a further 6 weeks training. After the total 12 weeks training the trainee will not be permitted to continue shooting unless they apply for membership of the Club and their application is accepted. Joining Fees are \$225 per Senior and \$155 per Junior. Family plans are available (costs subject to regular review). Club Uniform (shirt) may be purchased from the Treasurer.
