shooting should be completed around noon with presentations following shortly after.

Round to be shot is dependant on division, gender & bow type.  
(refer attached Conditions of Entry)

Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place (numbers permitting)  
in each of the 8 groups listed below.

All groups include both male & female archers.

Placings in each group will be determined using each archer's  
'off the bow' score plus their handicap points.

1. OPEN Recurve
2. OPEN Compound & Crossbow
3. MASTER Recurve
4. MASTER Compound & Crossbow
5. Vet/VetPlus Recurve
6. Vet/VetPlus Compound & Crossbow
7. B/bow & Longbow
8. YOUTH\*

\* Youth group is comprised of both male and female archers from all Youth divisions

### LEGEND:

**WA 60/900** round – 30 arrows @ 60m, 50m & 40m on a 122cm face. (60cm face for Crossbow)

**Short Canberra** round – 30 arrows @ 50m, 40m & 30m on a 122cm face.

**Junior Canberra** round – 30 arrows @ 40m, 30m & 20m on a 122cm face.

R=Recurve, C=Compound, B=Barebow, L=Longbow, X=Crossbow

### 2. Handicap

- Each competitor's entry details should also include their Archers Diary 'LAST 5' handicap rating.
- Any entry received with a handicap rating that is unable to be verified from Archers Diary will be given a handicap allowance of ZERO.  
ie. the archer's 'off the bow' score will be used to determine their position in the relevant group.

### 3. Groups

Dependant on the number of entries received in the various divisions  
Whiteman Park Archers reserve the right to increase the number of groups medals will be awarded to.
